Position Summary:

An internship with HOHI is a professional learning experience that offers meaningful, practical work related to international missions. This position gives a student the opportunity for career exploration and development, to learn new skills and firsthand ministry experience, as well as assist in the developmental phases of building a new mission organization. All positions are voluntary and non-paid.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Assist in the overall function of the ministry organization and outreaches
- Commit to daily personal devotionals
- Assist in various roles with hosting short-term mission teams
 - Help with prep work before the team's arrival
 - Ensure all necessary ministry/lunch items are prepared and ready for departure
 - Receive the team's lunch order (and help prepare if needed)
 - Fulfill designed role for specific day and/or week during mission team outreaches
 - Assist in other support roles when needed
- Prep medical pack/kit and oversee all medical roles/responsibilities during outreaches
- Develop and Design a spreadsheet for our Vitamin Program (includes both children and prenatal)
- Assist in Nutritional Program (prep and distribution of vitamins and food bags)
- Assist in creating lesson plans for each level/area of Bible Study (preschool, children and teens) *Women's Ministry optional*
- Prepare and share a kids devotional (location TBD)
- Help with prep work for different outreaches such as laminating Bible markers, lesson printouts, organizing lesson plans, etc (*we will schedule specific times for this*)
- Find Biblical correspondents/references for a variety of topics that we can share with the Lecture class in San Bartolome (*will explain more details*)
- Clearly communicate the vision and mission of Hands of Hope International
- Write a blog about serving as a foreign missionary

Overall Costs: \$2,500 (6 week internship); \$900 (2 week internship)

• Cost includes all necessary items such as on-ground transportation, lodging, daily meals and team activities. Individuals applying will also need to supply their own funding for personal purchases and additional activities while serving in Guatemala. Fundraising is permissible and encouraged.
